- be 70 or older (Please include age or birth date to be considered for qualification)
- have rendered service to seniors on a community, state or federal level, and
- be recognized as a role model for positive aging, and
- have demonstrated a life work acknowledged by general consensus as being of great benefit to a large number of people, or have made some significant contribution to society through occupational or volunteer efforts
