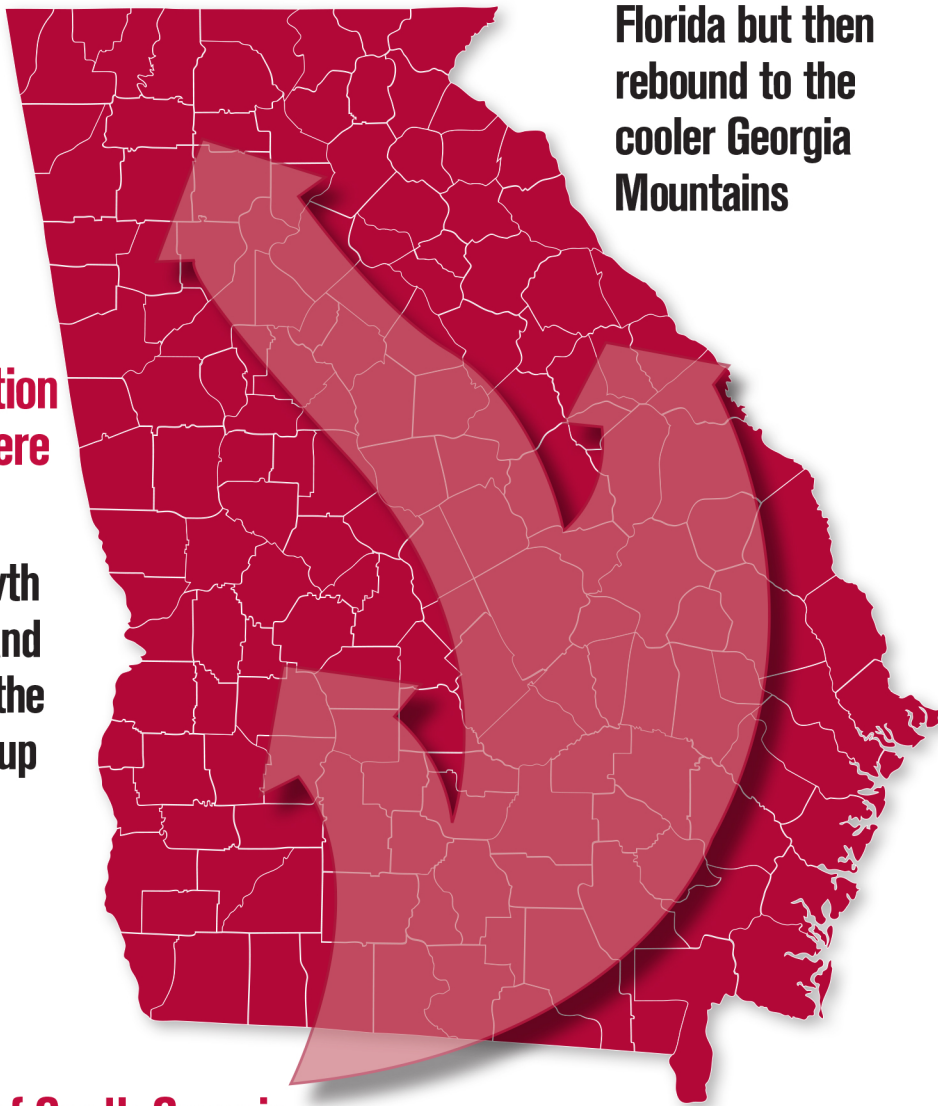


Georgia's Seniors on the Move
